Today we head north to Brugge and chocolate and lace and a day of sightseeing. Overnight Ypres



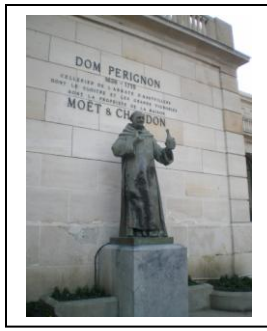
29th April
